HOTEL INFORMATION

A block of 75 rooms has been reserved for May 31st and June 1st for our registrants and exhibitors, which will be held until Monday, April 29, 2019.
After April 29th, any rooms remaining in the block will revert back to the resort for sale on a first-come, first-served basis at the prevailing rates.

The room rate of \$339.00 (Single Room or Double Room Rate) and is subject to Rhode Island and local tax of 13% per room per night, and also a \$1.00 Newport Tourism tax. There is a Resort Fee of \$30.00 per day, that has been discounted to \$15.00 per day and will be added to your room.

The Resort Fee includes overnight self-parking, Gurney's shuttle van transportation to/from downtown Newport, 2 bottled waters per guestroom per night, newspapers at the front desk, 24 hour access to the fitness center, unlimited local phone calls, on-property resort activities, Wireless Internet access in all guest rooms, meeting space and public areas. If valet parking is utilized, an additional \$5.00 fee would be added to your Resort Fee. All guest rooms are non-smoking.

The total 'per night' charge for your room will be $\$339.00 \times 13\% + \$15.00 + \$1.00$ [Newport Tourism Tax] = \$399.07.

To Make Your Room Reservations – Guests can begin booking their reservations under the **New England Society of Plastic and Reconstructive Surgeons** room block! Guests have the option of booking through the personalized link below or calling into the in-house Reservations Team at **1 833-235-7500** [this phone number shows on all agents' phones so the next available agent can assist you]. Guests can reserve a Standard King or Double Double through the link. Any guest wanting to upgrade their room to a water view or a suite, can do so by calling into the Reservations Team. Again – please make sure to mention that you are with the **NESPRS – New England Society of Plastic and Reconstructive Surgeons** room block when speaking with the agent in order to take advantage of the Meeting Room Rate.

To guarantee your reservation, the hotel requires a deposit for the first night's room and taxes.

MEETING REGISTRATION – EXHIBITORS

You will need your name badge and your 'Boat Ticket' [behind your badge] in order to board the boat. **NO EXCEPTIONS!** You will return to Gurney's Dock at 5:30PM.

Be creative, but make it 'dressy / business'. Full tuxedo dress is definitely welcome!!

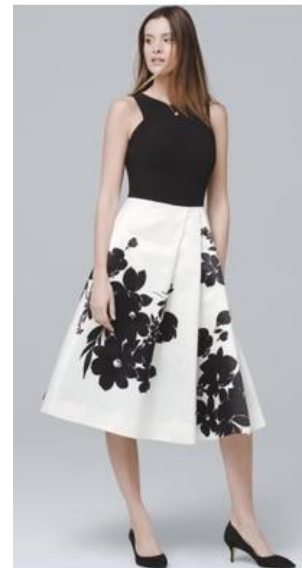
